N.B. Roadé Parish Council can only authorise the opening of a purchased grave with the permission of the owner or to inter the owner. In all other cases ownership must be transferred to someone who can legally prove that they are entitled to receive these ownership rights. Whilst the Council will offer all assistance in establishing the means of transfer, responsibility remains with the funeral arranger to have clarified this matter before booking.

NOTES

- 1 A grant of exclusive right of burial is approved for a period of 100 years.
- 2 A fee is payable according to the scale of charges in force at the time of application.
- 3 Applications for purchased plots in respect of former residents will normally be restricted to one per family. The charge will be doubled in such cases.
- 4 No application for a reserved grave space will be accepted from a person with no previous connection with the parish of Roade, except in exceptional circumstances. Charges will be doubled for approved applications.
